Free Performances Every Day at 6 p.m. on the Kennedy Center Millennium Stage

As part of its effort to make the performing arts available to everyone, the Kennedy Center offers a free performance every day on the Millennium Stage in the Grand Foyer. These performances of music, theater, and dance feature emerging and established artists from the Washington area and across the nation; “State Days” programs celebrate the unique cultures and art forms found in every American state; and Artists-in-Residence perform several times during a particular month.

Free Tours of the Kennedy Center Every Day are given by the Friends of the Kennedy Center volunteers Monday-Friday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., with the last tour starting at approximately 4:45 p.m. On Saturday and Sunday, tours are offered from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Use the **Kennedy Center Show Shuttle** to and from the METRO subway. **Free every day.** Ride METRO Blue or Orange Line to the Foggy Bottom/GWU Station, and take the Kennedy Center Show Shuttle --departing every 15 minutes every day 8 a.m. to midnight.
